Mike Enders served as the General Contractor and builder for our home at the American Ranch in Prescott. It was a pleasure to work with Mike and I was extremely pleased with his leadership and management of the construction. Mike brought fiscal responsibility, quality workmanship, attention to detail, creative ideas and special attention to our project.

We pursued certification with the Department of Energy's Energy Star program, and Mike met or exceeded all requirements under the Builders Option Program (BOP) certification which is more rigorous and detailed than their normal certification process. In addition, Mike oversaw the development of our water recovery and catchment development to allow for rainwater recovery for irrigation around our home, unique in our community. We installed radiant floor heating on the ground floor of our residence and Mike oversaw the upgrade of subfloor and edge insulation enhancement beyond what the installer company was planning, an insight and analytical understanding that will save us energy for years to come. Mike also oversaw the design, installation, test and integration of our 16,400 KWH photovoltaic solar project which is providing enough electricity to power our home during the year. This was an integrated net-metering installation which required coordination with the solar provider, the electrician and APS for proper installation and setup.
